

# Who's Who?

Divide students into pairs. Ask each student to write the name of an organism on a sticky note, and then stick the note on his or her partner's back. Students may need a strip of masking tape to help ensure the note stays stuck on the clothing. Instruct students to move around the room to ask other students questions and gather clues about what their organism may be. Each student should ask niche-related questions such as:

- Is this organism a plant or an animal?
- Is this organism nocturnal or diurnal?
- What does this organism eat or how does it make energy?
- Does this organism prefer sun or shade?
- What type of environment does this organism live in?
- What eats this organism?

Give students about 5-10 minutes to ask questions, and then have students take their seats. Go around the room, asking each student to make an educated guess about the identity of their organism. Have their partner remove the sticky note to find out if the guess was correct.
